Subject: - Regarding news item titled “Most crime against women go unsolved” appeared in the Metro Now on 15-10.2008

Sir.

The caption of the news item “Most crime against women go unsolved” appeared in the Metro Now on 15.10.2008 is found factually incorrect and misleading. The news item has discussed only three unsolved cases relating to the years 2003, 2007 and 2008.

The reporter has not taken care to verify the record of solving crimes by Delhi Police. Over the years solving heinous crime and specially crime against women has been on the top priority of Delhi Police. The last five years have witnessed 92% to 95% cases of rape and 92% of cases relating molestation of women being solved.

In view of the above stated facts and circumstances, it is requested that the correct facts of the matter may be published with the same prominence for your esteemed readers. It will also be appreciated if the reporter advised to get the facts verified from the concerned authority before publishing such sensitive matters which tends to cause alarm among the general public.
